**Money** ..... Euro (EUR), Italian lira (ITL)  
**Climate** ..... Predominately Mediterranean, Alpine in far north, hot & dry in south  
**Primary language** ..... Italian (official), German (parts of Trentino-Alto Adige region are predominantly German speaking), French (small French speaking minority in Valle d' Aosta region), Slovene (Slovene-speaking minority in the Trieste-Gorizia area)  
**Leader** ..... Prime Minister Silvio Berlusconi  
 The President of Italy is Giorgio Napolitano—but is only a ceremonial figure—the Prime Minister is the one who runs the country!  
**Italian Inventions** ..... Ice Cream Cone, Cologne, Thermometer, Piano, Eyeglasses, Typewriter, Espresso Machine

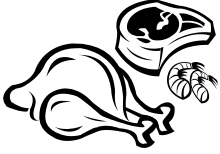


What does Mia Cucina mean in Italian?



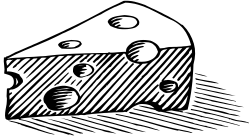

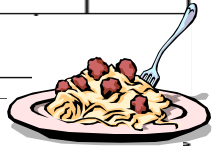
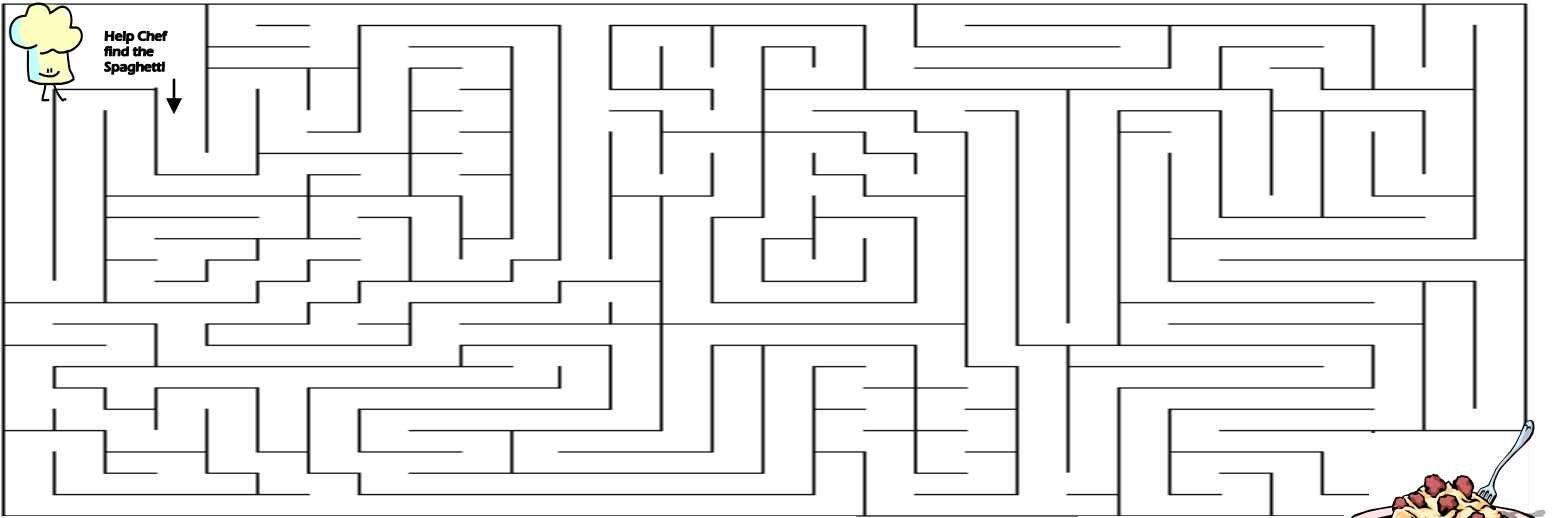
